MINUTES, BILLS and TREASURERS REPORT: Denny motioned to approve the minutes for December 2019 and January 6, 2020 Reorganization; Brian second, with a roll call vote-unanimous yes-motion carried. Lori motioned to approve the bills; Linda second, with a roll call vote-unanimous yes-motion carried. Ron motioned to approve the treasurer's report; Denny second, with a roll call vote-unanimous yes-motion carried.
